

Cannot Add a New Student – Foreign Key Error

Symptoms: When attempting to add new student, you receive error that says there is a foreign key constraint, or that the ID may be in use.

Possible causes:

- Student ID value is a duplicate of one already used
- You previously removed or changed a default value from a reference table in the database that is required to add a new student record

Diagnosing and fixing:

- 1. Check if you are trying to use a duplicate Student ID value. If this is not the problem, proceed to the next step.
- 2. Choose **Setup** from **Display** dropdown.
- 3. Check these reference tables for the existence of the indicated records (the values indicated must match exactly):
 - a. Class Periods: ID= <not set> , Description = <not set>
 - b. Companies: ID= <not set> , Description = <not set> , Active is checked
 - c. Contact Types: ID= <not set>
 - d. **Ethnicity**: ID=-, Description=<not set> (Note a single dash in the ID field)
 - e. Grade Levels: ID= <not set> , Description = <not set>
 - f. **Platoons**: ID= <not set> , Description = <not set> , Company ID = <not set> choice, Active is checked
 - g. Ranks: ID= <not set> , Description = <not set> , Type=ENL, Sort Order =99
 - h. Squads: ID= <not set> , Description = <not set> , Platoon ID = <not set> , Active is checked

These are required fields that should not be altered or removed.
